- 3. LAMB WAS TYPE (POINTED TO COMING MESSIAH

- 4.TOOK PLACE ON 14<sup>TH</sup>

CONCLUSION: SCRIPTURE INDICATES THAT THE CEREMONY OF THE LAST SUPPER MUST CONTINUE UNTIL CHRIST COMES THE SECOND TIME. THIS CEREMONY OF THE BREAD AND WINE IS A PERPETUAL REMINDER OF THE PRICE THAT CHRIST PAID FOR LOST MAN'S SALVATION; HE FREELY GAVE HIS PERSONAL BLOOD. THIS GIFT LED TO HIS DEATH, WHICH WAS FOLLOWED BY HIS RESURRECTION. THAT RESURRECTION PROVED THAT HE IS THE SOURCE OF LIFE AND MANKIND'S SOURCE OF VICTORY OVER DEATH.

THE LAST SUPPER, ALSO, IS A REMINDER THAT THE NEW COVENANT, RATIFIED BY CHRIST'S BLOOD, REPLACED THE OLD COVENANT, RATIFIED BY THE BLOOD OF ANIMALS. ALSO, THE NEW COVENANT REPLACED THE MOSAIC LAW, INCLUDING TITHING, CEREMONIAL "HOLY DAYS," ANNUAL "SABBATHS," CIRCUMCISION, AND ANIMAL SACRIFICES.
