PARALLELISM IN HEBREW POETRY:

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ENJOY HEBREW POETRY MORE BY UNDERSTANDING ITS
FUNDAMENTAL STRUCTURAL FOUNDATION. RATHER THAN BEING
FOUNDED ON REGULARITY OF METER AND RHYME, IT IS FOUNDED
ON SIMILARITY OR DISSIMILARITY OF STRUCTURE. SEE THE
EXAMPLES BELOW:

PSALM 23, EXAMPLE:

(A) DISSIMILAR PARALLELISM

THE **LORD** IS MY SHEPHERD,

I SHALL NOT WANT.

(NOTE, THE SUBJECT CHANGES FROM LINE ONE TO LINE TWO.)

(B) <u>SIMILAR</u> PARALLELISM

HE MAKETH ME TO LIE DOWN IN GREEN PASTURE,

HE LEADETH ME BESIDE THE STILL WATERS,

HE RESTORETH **MY** SOUL.

(NOTE: "HE" IS THE SUBJECT OF ALL THREE LINES. "ME/MY" ARE THE FOCUS OF GOD'S GUIDANCE. STRUCTURE OF LINES IS SIMILAR.)
